Vision: Giving heavy wings to fly!

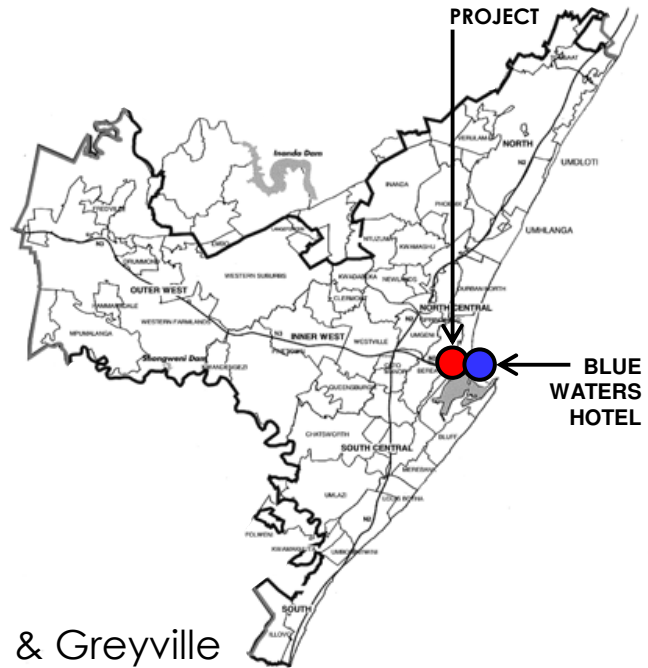
What: Careline Crisis and Trauma Centre's main areas of focus include

- A help desk - which assists with options and referrals
- Crisis teams on 24 hour call out - after an incident it is imperative debriefing takes place as soon as possible. Incidents include assault, rape, hi-jacking, armed robbery, traffic accidents, domestic violence, house breaking, theft, alcohol and drug abuse
- Bridging home - a stable environment for all ages, male and female. Residents are given the opportunity to be re-integrated into society, the community, schools and families
- Counseling and support groups
- Drug and alcohol life skills program - dealing with self-esteem, coping skills, anger management, time management and emotional intelligence
- Work skills - is a vital stage of recovery as it offers the individual purpose and direction for the new lifestyle. It includes personal and fundamental training in proposals, C.V's, and understanding the difference between a job and a career, plus:
 - i. Money matters: budgeting, etc
 - ii. Business communications: including punctuality, dress sense, goal setting, body language and emotional maturity in the workplace
- Development and follow-up of new crisis centres in KwaZulu Natal

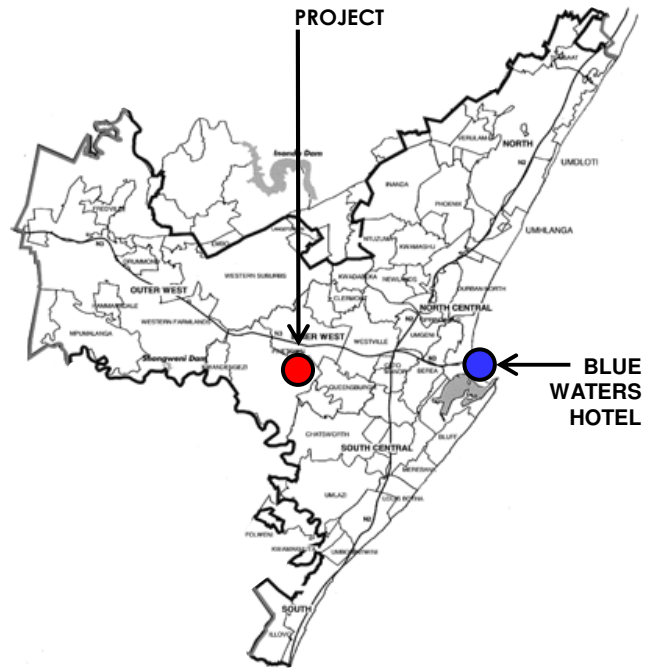

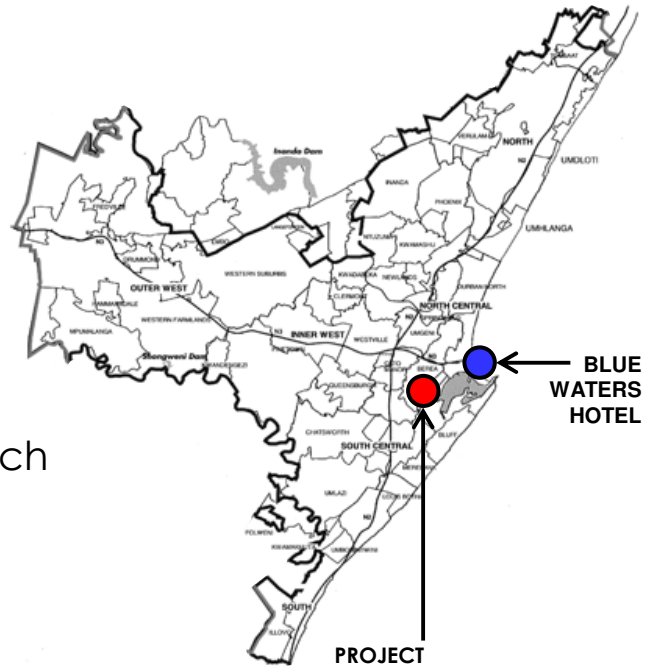

 - o A home school, providing specialised education to approximately 25 children who are disadvantaged and have found it difficult to fit within mainstream schools
 - o A Feeding scheme - part of early intervention and preventative outreach work, attempting to feed more than 900 needy children in the Chesterville and Mayville areas
- A soccer academy and school for children from underprivileged backgrounds, ran from the church premises
- A home for women in crisis

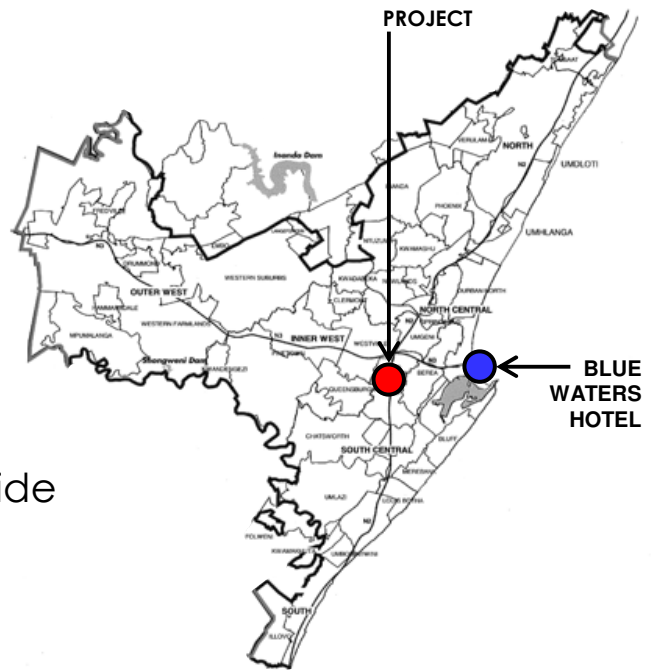

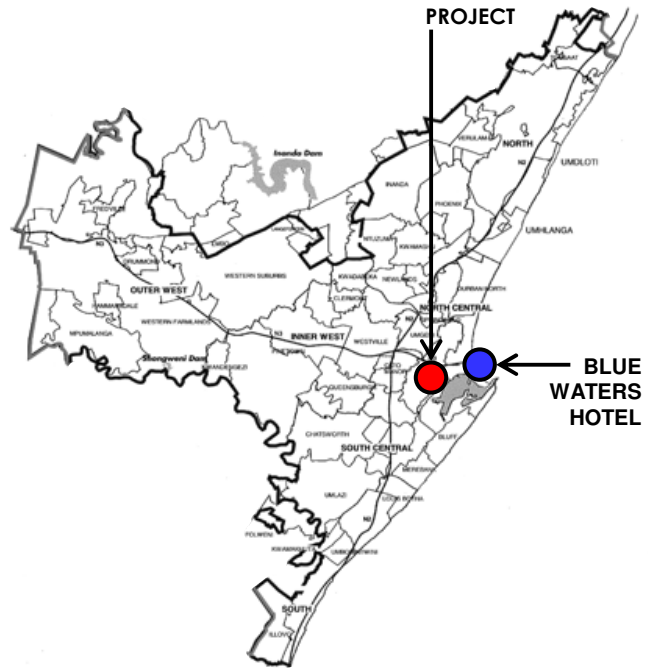
- **FEED** each orphan daily at school, and provide monthly groceries and toiletries

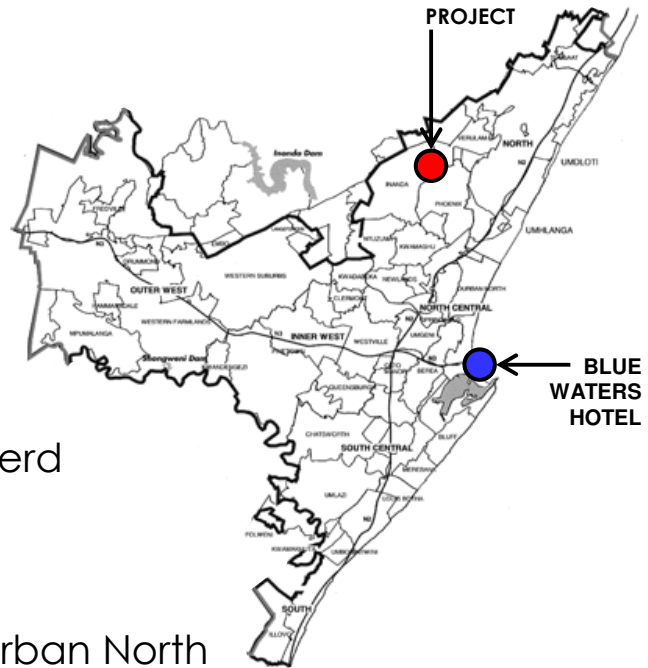

Project started: 2004

Geographical area: Amaoti and Durban North

Vision: Indlela's primary objective is to oversee the work carried out by a number of community projects working into the North Durban and Amaoti areas. It serves as a covering body for several projects. The purpose of Indlela is to create an environment where these projects can develop and grow to their full potential.

What: Indlela's projects currently include:

Fair Havens Transition Home - a home for abandoned babies that require adoption into a family environment.

Door of Hope - this project includes a free facility for Trauma and Crisis Counseling and Support, as well as a Life Skills program into the Amaoti community aimed at developing life skills among teenagers with a specific emphasis on AIDS awareness and prevention.

Life Skills - the overall goal of the Life Skills Programme is to impact young people in Amaoti, who are under threat from HIV/Aids. The aim is to interact with these children before they are sexually active or at least before they develop any sexual habits. In doing so, the emphasis is on developing individual value, vision and responsibility. We aim to develop within the individual a realization of their destiny and help them develop a personal vision to enable them to plan for a future without HIV/Aids. We believe a long term initiative that works deeply into the lives of core groups of learners, is more likely to cause behaviour change and impact others around them

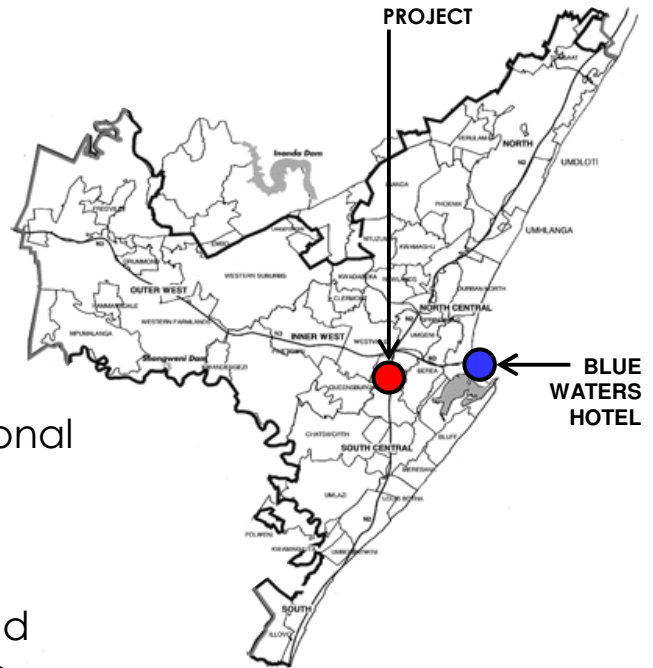
Feeding Programme - here the focus is on a feeding program that provides daily food to hundreds of young children in formal and informal crèches in the Amaoti Township.

Breast milk Bank:

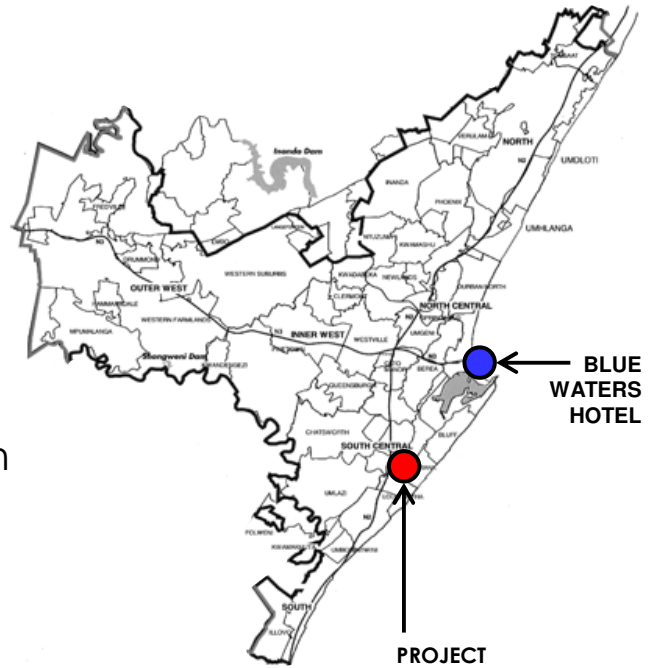
- Donor mothers investing in the well-being of HIV/AIDS orphans

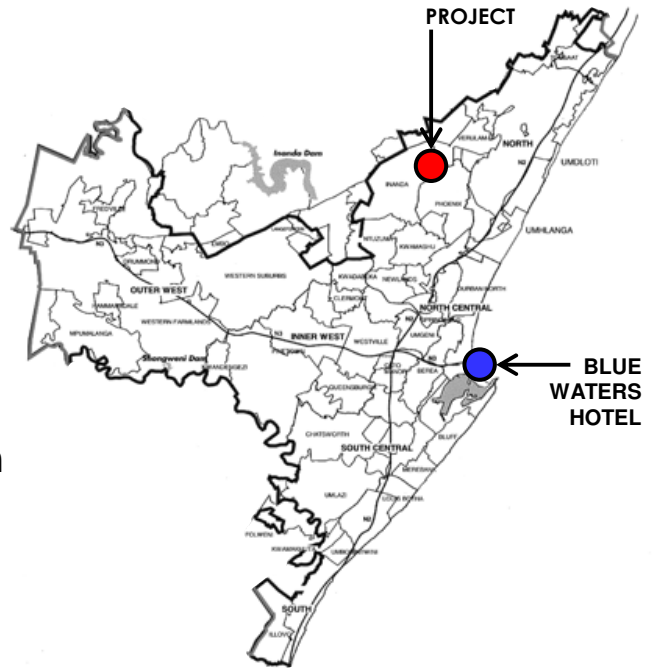
What: The youth work at Montclair Methodist Church goes under the name of JC.com. It's main areas of focus are:

Project: Lungisani Indlela

Church: Amaoti Community Church

Project started: 2007

Geographical area: Amaoti

Vision: To transform and empower the lives of the people and children of Amaoti, bringing them hope for the future. To see every shack come down and houses built and repaired; to see trees planted; survival vegetable gardens established; every orphan cared for; to see entrepreneurial businesses established within Amaoti; to introduce sports, dance, drama, art and crafts - that no-one will be idle as they develop a transformed work and play ethic.

What: Lungisani Indlela's main areas of focus are:

Back-to-School - 617 children from Amaoti are on the Back-to-School programme. Individuals sponsor school uniforms, school fees and stationary. The project employs youth workers (previously unemployed members of the Amaoti community) who have been trained and equipped to work with these children. They work closely with the teachers and the children and do home visits to monitor the family situation.

Aftercare - this runs everyday from one of the local schools. Orphans and vulnerable children are helped with homework, spelling and reading.

Teenage Empowerment Programme (TEP) - this is a life skills programme that the project runs in two high schools in Amaoti.

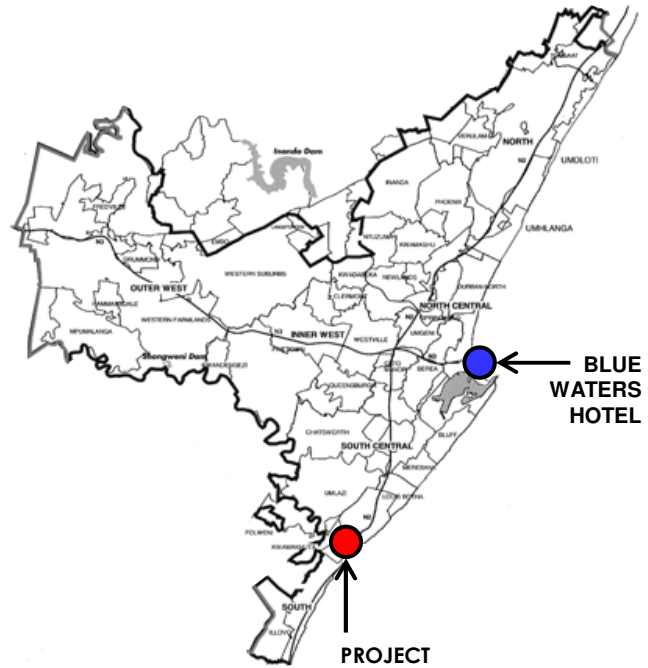
Crèche Development - Lungisani Indlela itself operates a crèche of 65 children and assists in the resourcing of 19 other crèches in Amaoti where the numbers increase daily. The teachers receive training and resources from the project.

Feeding - presently the project feeds children in 19 of the crèches they support everyday of the week, feeding a total of 1000 children.

Khulakakahle Day Care Centre - a crèche in Bhekulwandle township, providing care for children from 1 to 5 years old.

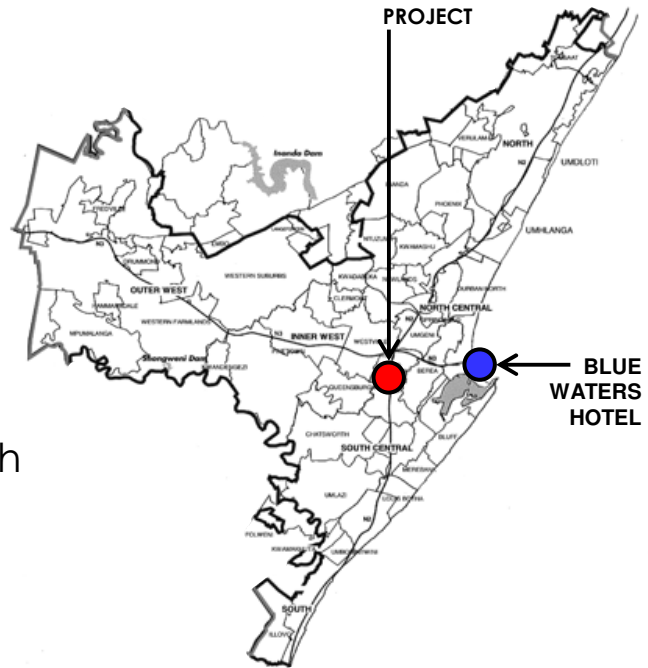

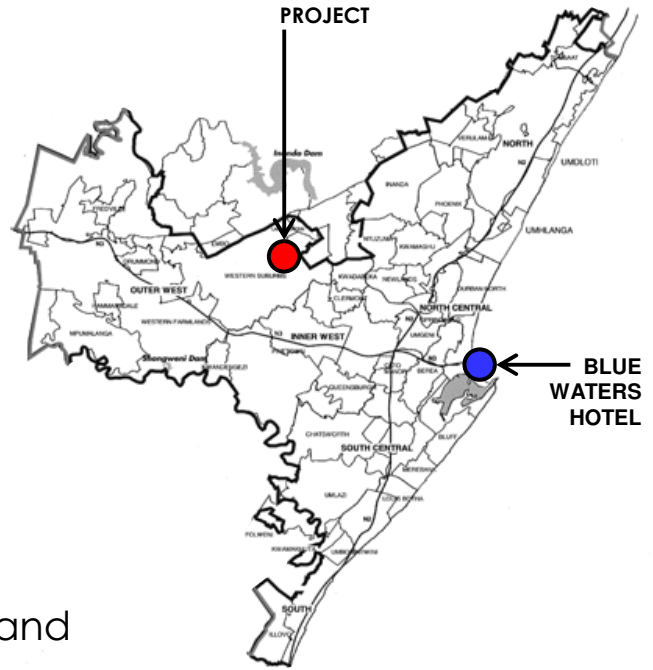
What: Onthatile's main areas of focus are:

Project started: 2004

Geographical area: Lower Molweni and Umgababa

Vision: Using Jesus as our model, we long to meet the needs of poor and disempowered people, especially in Lower Molweni and Umgababa

What: Philangethemba's main areas of focus are

Education Portfolio - aims to help improve the quality of education for the three schools in the Lower Molweni and Umgababa valleys. Teams conduct Saturday school for grades 10, 11 and 12 in English, Maths and Science. Members of the parish also provide assistance to the teachers of these subjects. Philangethemba provides teaching on Christian-based life skills, using material provided by Scripture Union. The Philangethemba-funded teacher is assisted by a number of community volunteers.

HIV/AIDS Portfolio - has created a strategic link to a community committee known as Lower Molweni and Umgababa HIV and Aids Program (LUHAP), through which it conducts all of its interventions. The major initiative of the past 12 months has been the refurbishing and equipping of two child care centres which provide facilities for Orphans and Vulnerable Children after school giving them care and a meal while their primary caregivers are working or otherwise unavailable.

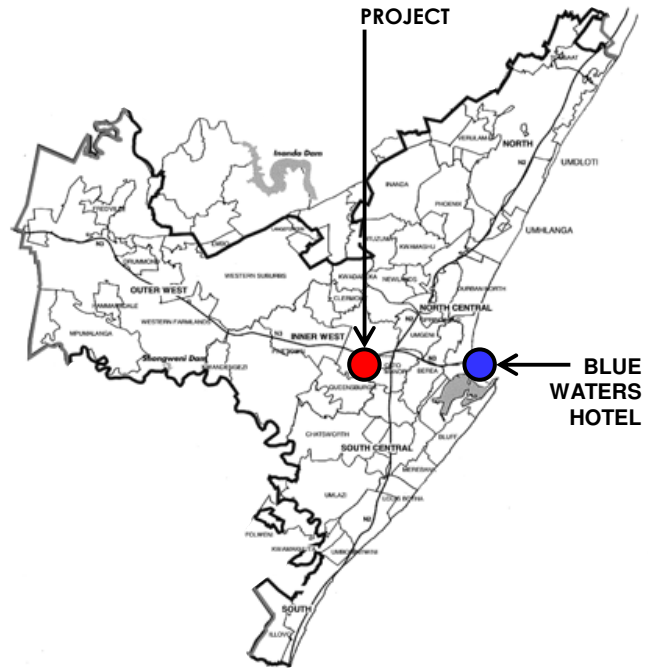
Income Generation Portfolio - targets to stimulate small business and other initiatives to create income opportunities for the community. A number of small business opportunities have been made available, most of which are craft based labour intensive ventures.

How delegates might be involved:

- Holiday club
- Constructing and upgrading recreational facilities within the community, e.g. building a shelter for local school children, improving the community soccer field
- Helping local youth with basic computer skills

Vision: To create a safe environment for underprivileged and HIV+ women to share their stories

The project first started when a member of the church discovered she was HIV positive. After receiving support herself, she was able to see the need to empower other women to live positively and the benefit of forming a support group. Being a counselor herself, she went around visiting people that she thought suffered from HIV infection and encouraged them to come and join their group where they could meet other women in similar circumstances. The group has grown to a considerable size and they spent time together in prayer and visiting other struggling women.

Skill development

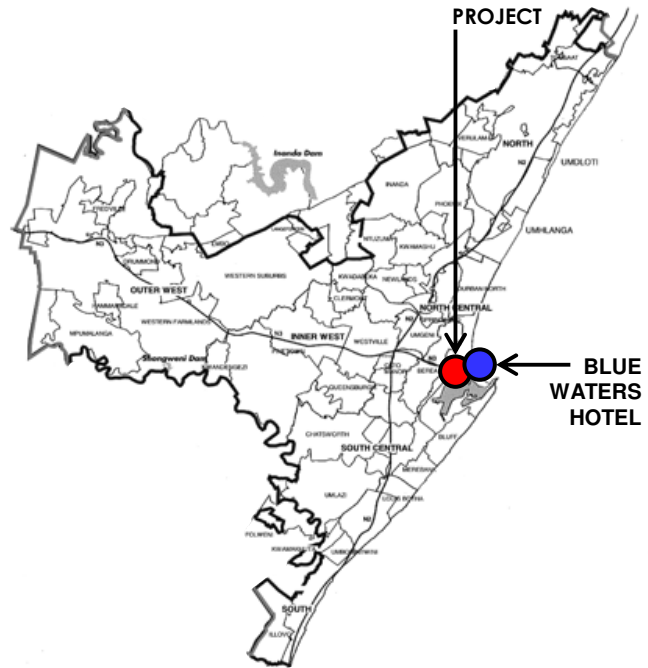
- To develop themselves to become self – sufficient by making crafts such as beaded necklaces, earrings, headbands, cellphone pouches, etc

- o meeting and drawing extra children in from within the local community / city centre

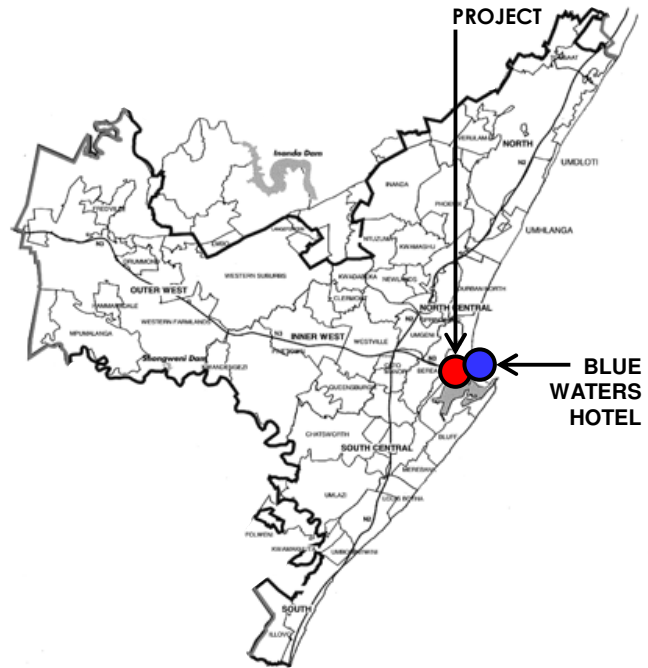

Project: The Well Turnaround Centre

Project started: 2009

Geographical area: Durban Central

What: The mission of The Well Turnaround Centre will be, through a network of organisations and programs, to provide opportunities for change and upliftment. The main objective is to teach the individual a multitude of skills to empower them to self-sufficiency.

What: Some of the Inner City Project's main areas of focus are

- Skills for employability training programmes
- Employment linkage programmes
- Counseling and support programmes
- Accommodation linkage

In addition to these existing initiatives, the local government has recently assigned 85 Anton Lembede / Smith Street as a Turnaround Centre for the homeless and unemployed. They have chosen a team people, all Christians, who are specialist in their various areas of intervention to the poor, to setup a sustainable turnaround initiative.

The centre will comprise a shelter for destitute families, a street children's reception centre, a job centre, 24 hour counseling centre, shelter for abused women and children, after care facility for latch key kids and will be the central point for all current feeding schemes operating in the area.

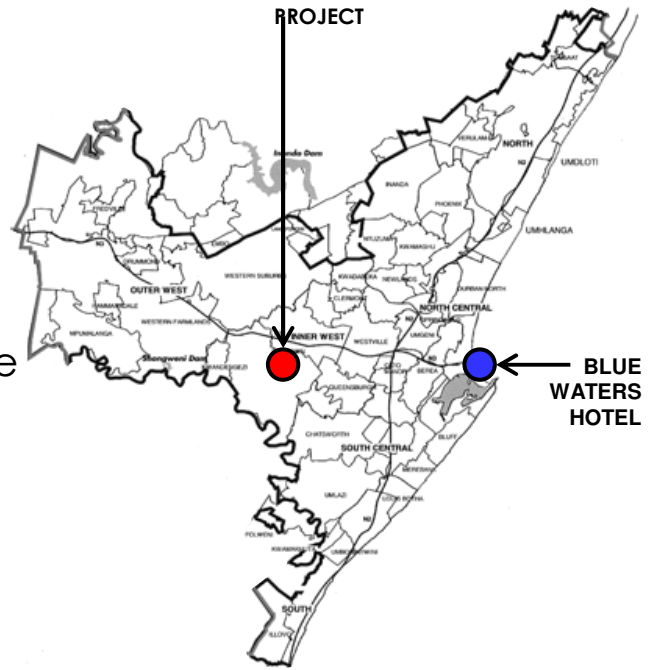
How delegates might be involved:

- The project ear marked for July is the revamp the building, which is the Point area of Durban
- Depending on the timing, the delegates may be involved with surveys of the homeless alongside trained professionals, data capture, building revamping - cleaning, painting, etc
- They may also be included in the city home group meetings at Glenridge - 120 homeless, unemployed, under employed or refugee community of believers

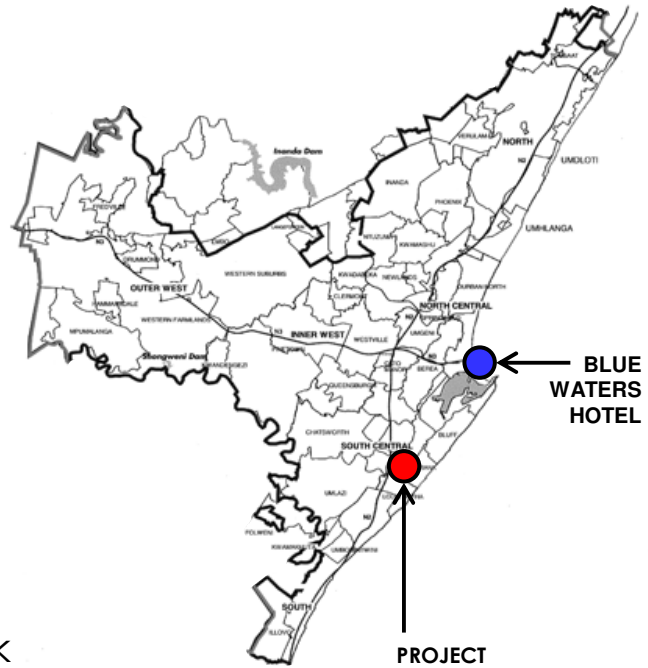

Vision: A privileged school for the underprivileged

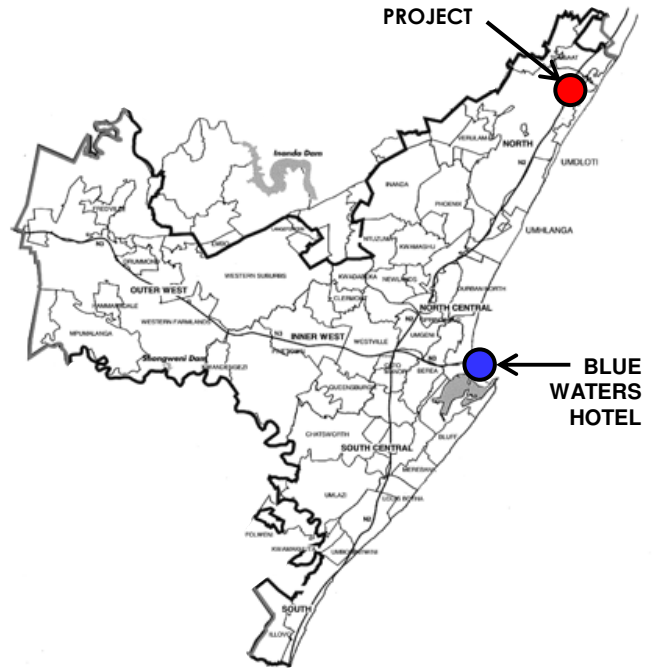
What: The school exists to give hope through love and education to children from poor and marginalized backgrounds

Vision: To demonstrate God's love through the provision of a place of hope and welcome, where people can be cared for and empowered during their time of need and suffering from HIV/AIDS

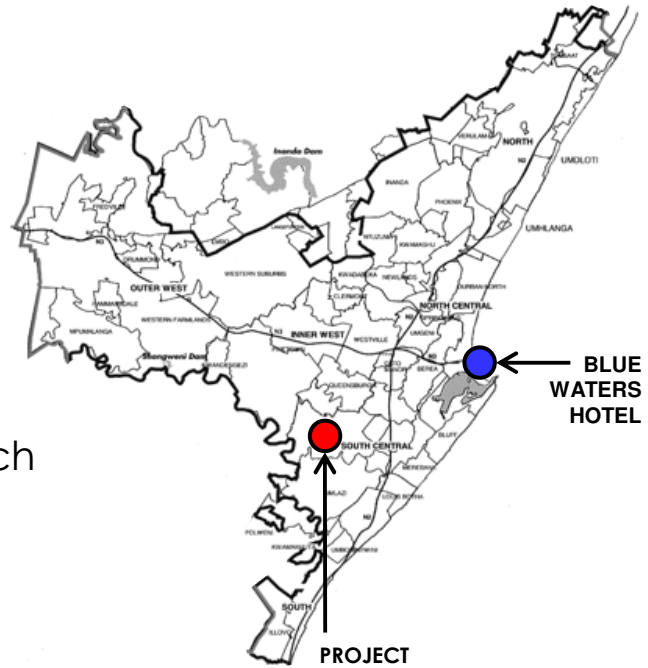
What: Umuzi Wethemba KwaJesu offers services in six main areas

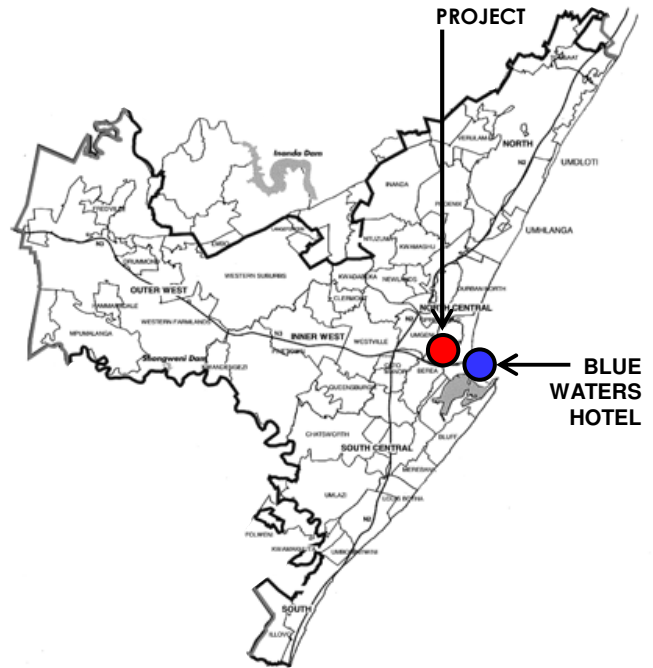

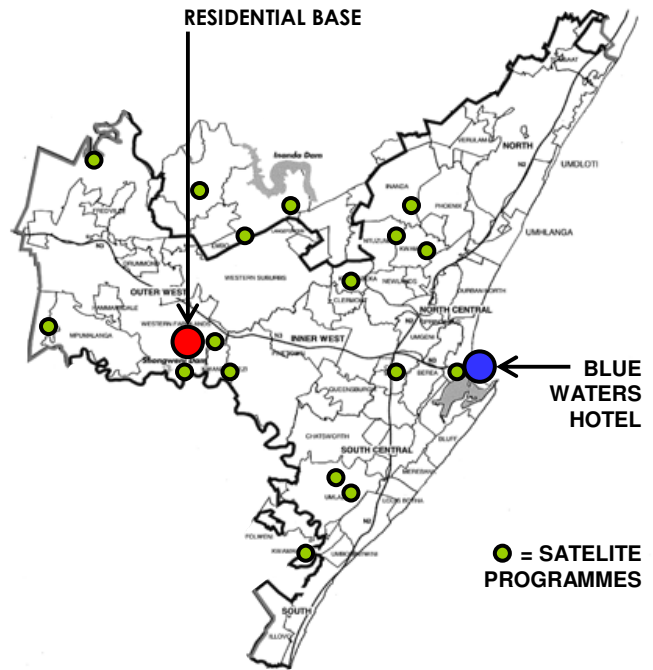

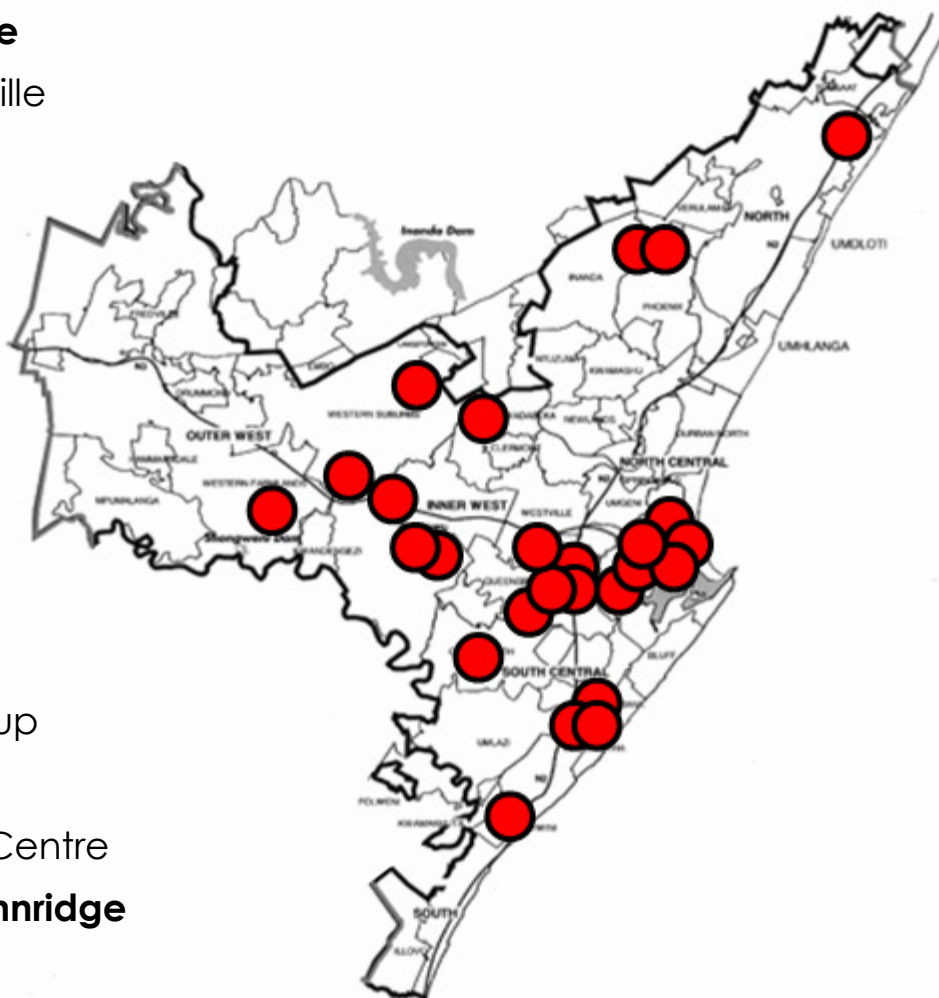
